

STATE OF DELAWARE Foreign Trade Zone No. 99

Foreign-Trade Zone No. 99, which is operated as a public utility under **Foreign-Trade Zones Board** Regulations, is located within **Delaware Department of State, Division of Small Business**, 99 Kings Highway, Dover, Delaware 19901. The sites within FTZ No. 99 are equipped to provide private storage, manipulation, manufacturing, and office space. The following companies have been **approved** as **Designated** by **US Foreign Trade Zone Board** and **Activated** by **Customs and Border Protection** with **Concurrence** by **State of Delaware's Grantee Administrator** as of *April 15, 2023*:



- **Port of Wilmington**, Magnet Site #1 – All industries
- **Citrosuco North America**, located at Port of Wilmington, Site #011 (Food/Juice)
- **Delaware City Refining**, Subzone #99E (Petroleum)
- **Delaware Freeport**, Subzone #99G (General Purpose Warehouse/Art Storage)
- **Bloom Energy**, Subzone #99I (Manufacturing)
- **AstraZeneca Pharmaceuticals**, Subzone #99D (Manufacturing)

The US Foreign Trade Program offers improved cash flow through:

DUTY DEFERRAL – Duties are delayed unless & until imports leave the FTZ and enter US Customs Territory

DUTY REDUCTION - Inverted Tariff rate on material based on potential change in HTS*

DUTY EXEMPTION – NO Duty on re-exported or scrap

Reduced merchandise processing fees (MPFs)	More precise inventory and cost control
Streamlined logistics	No time limit on storage
Eliminate Duty Drawback Delays	Faster speed-to-market
No duties on waste, scrap, or defective parts	Zone to Zone In-Bond Transfers
